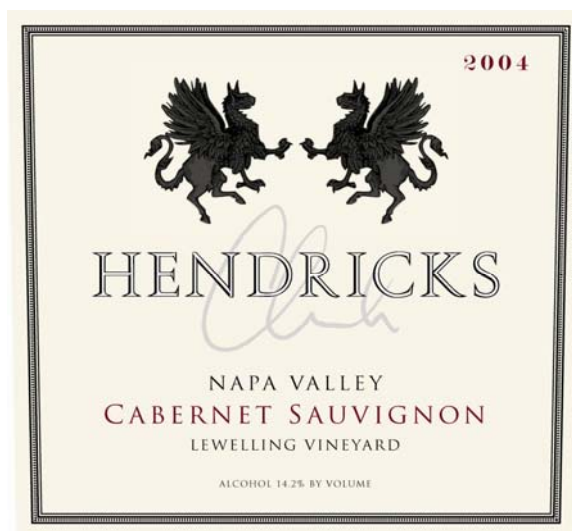


The inaugural release of Charles Hendricks wine collection.



2004 Hendricks Cabernet Sauvignon Lewelling Vineyards, Napa Valley

This 2004 Cabernet Sauvignon was exceptional from the beginning... with dense, luxuriant fruit and a wonderfully silky texture. The harvest of 2004 was referred to as the “fast and furious” as the entire Valleys’ fruit came to maturity in the month of September; notably one of the earliest harvests on record in over two decades. A year of small yields and exceptional quality were gloriously bestowed upon us by Mother Nature.

Winemaker Notes:

A Beautiful opaque garnet hue immediately coats the glass, followed by a rush of intoxicating aromas of vanilla, plum, rose and candied cherries with undertones of tar, sweet toast and exotic spices. Immense, silky and lush fruit envelops the palate with an expansive long, lingering gratifying finish.

The 2004 Hendricks Cabernet Sauvignon was bottled in January, 2007 and released late October, 2008, allowing an additional 22 months of bottle age before release. With the additional bottle age, it has allowed the stunning wine to settle and soften...Although drinking beautifully now; it will only improve with proper long term cellaring.
